



Conrad Bali Weddings: Frequently Asked Questions

1. How far in advance should I book my wedding at Conrad Bali?

There is no minimum lead time when a wedding reservation must be made. We are happy to confirm your wedding event in our resort provided that the venue of your choice is still available on your selected date and time. Ideally, we recommend our couples to book six to 12 months in advance to allow ample time to carefully plan your special day.

2. When is the best time for a wedding in Bali? What are the seasons in Bali?

In general, June to September is the most popular months to visit Bali. During these months, there is very little rain and the air is cool – the perfect time for dream tropical weddings.

3. When are the peak and low seasons for weddings in Bali?

According to the seasons, June to September tend to be the busiest season in Bali as the weather is best. November to February, with the exception of Christmas and New Year period and other holidays are less busy times.

4. How many wedding venues do you have?

We have five venues available for wedding ceremonies: Infinity, an iconic purpose built wedding chapel overlooking the Indian Ocean with a capacity of 60 guests is ideal for stylish contemporary weddings. We also have the Water Garden and Floating Garden, which can be decorated in both Balinese or contemporary style for a garden wedding, as well as Beach Bale for an intimate wedding or vow renewal setting for up to 18 guests. Our ballroom is designed to host the most glamorous private events in formal yet contemporary elegance. Seats up 230 guests including dance floor and stage, the Ballroom can be transformed into a magical setting with the help of any of our recommended wedding designers.

5. What wedding packages do you have?

Our Harmony Package provides you with basic requirements at Infinity including the usage of your selected wedding venues, a wedding celebrant, contemporary flower decoration, music accompaniment by wedding singers and a keyboardist, bridal bouquet and boutonniere, wedding program, welcome drinks and a commemorative certificate.

Splendor Package at Infinity provides our couples with ultimate value, with a fireworks display, contemporary fire dance performance and lantern decoration during the evening reception following your wedding ceremony.

Divine Package is an alternative for couples wishing to have a garden wedding ceremony, with your choice of two beautiful gardens with magnificent views.

Serene Package is designed for just the two of you to have a romantic beachfront wedding.

6. How long will a wedding ceremony take?

Depending on the nature of the ceremony and the religious belief according to which it is performed, a wedding ceremony may take as little as 25 minutes and as long as one and a half hours. Please consult our wedding specialists on your preferences and any religious requirements you may like to follow.

7. What venues are available for a wedding reception?

From small intimate parties to big celebrations Conrad Bali has a world-class array of exceptionally stylish and authentically Balinese venues where you can host your special event. Outdoor venues include Ocean Garden, a manicured lawn with water views, which can accommodate up to 350 guests for a reception. Other outdoor reception venues are Infinity Garden and Floating Garden, both with capacity of 80 guests, Azure Court, which seats up to 60 guests, and Water Garden, which provides the perfect setting for an evening of cocktails.

Indoor reception venues include our 531 sqm Ballroom, which seats up to 230 guests and our range of award winning dining outlets including RIN, Suku, and Eight Degrees South.

8. If I confirm my wedding at Conrad Bali, am I obligated to book both my wedding ceremony and reception?

At Conrad Bali, you are welcome to arrange your wedding ceremony or reception only, or both. Our wedding packages are designed to accommodate the different requirements from our couples.

9. I am not sure how many guests I will have on my wedding, what should I do?

Although we understand that you may not have a fixed number of guests upon reserving your venue and event, an approximate number of guests is required. As we continue in the planning process, we will certainly have a clearer idea on the total number of guests attending. Three days prior to the wedding day, we will require a final number of guests as a minimum guarantee.

10. What kind of menu do you serve for wedding receptions?

Our menu options are extensive and certainly customizable. We serve everything; from local to international cuisines. Director of Food and Beverage and Culinary Operations, David Laval ensures whatever the wedding's theme, guests will be satisfied and pleasantly surprised. Set menu, buffet and live stations can be used in various combination.

11. Do you organize a food tasting before the wedding day?

We are pleased to organize a food tasting once your wedding is confirmed and it is available for up to four people.

12. Should wome of my guests have special dietary restrictions and requirements, will Conrad Bali be able to cater for these requirements?

Certainly, please advise our wedding specialists on your guests' special dietary requirements and their menus will be adjusted.

13. May I serve my own food or wedding cake?

We are very careful in serving our guests. Hygiene and food quality are very important to Conrad Bali's reputation. We may cater for some requests for customers to tailor food to their local or ethnic specialities or traditional cuisines and these are considered on a case by case basis.

14. May I serve my own beverage?

We do provide a selection of beverages including wines, champagne and other alcoholic drinks. If you decide to serve your own beverages in the form of gifts from your guests, a corkage fee will be applied per opened bottle based on the type of beverage.

15. Do you have restrictions on the timing of indoor and outdoor weddings?

In consideration of the local community, outdoor events should conclude by 10pm. Indoor events may continue until midnight. After parties can be arranged in our indoor function spaces, which may run until 2am.

16. Do you have a dedicated team to assist in the wedding planning process?

Our wedding sales team is available to help you plan your wedding, while the operational team oversees the reception from beginning to end. Private wedding planners can also be accommodated.

17. Do you do host ethnic weddings?

We have catered to many different ethnic weddings including Indian and Chinese.

18. Apart from the wedding ceremony and reception venue, what other services do you provide for couples wanting to get married at Conrad Bali?

We are also able to assist you in organising other services including decoration, photography, wedding cake, entertainment and legalisation of your marriage. Please contact our wedding specialists for details.

19. Do you have suggested vendors for flowers, music, entertainment and photography?

We work with you to source all of these items from partners and trusted suppliers.

20. May I hire my own photographer, make up artist, decorator or entertainment?

We are happy to assist you organising the details of your event, including photography and professional make up artist services, decoration, entertainment and even legalisation of your marriage. All arrangements are done by our preferred vendors to ensure that we maintain the aesthetics of our venues as well as have a quality control on the décor undertaken inside the hotel premises. Under certain circumstances we may allow trusted outside contractors with an assurance bond to work with our contractor agreement and policy.

21. My spouse and I do not live in Bali. I am afraid we will not have enough time to fly back and forth to Bali during our planning. How will the organization take place?

Our wedding sales team will fully assist you in planning your special day. We advise at least two visits to be made prior to your day. The first visit will allow you to experience firsthand the facilities and services provided by Conrad Bali, as well as viewing the venues. Upon confirmation and initial planning, a second visit should be arranged to finalise the details including food tasting, make up, rehearsal, and decoration details. This can even be combined with your pre wedding photoshoot trip. We will continue to actively communicate to you on updates and the next stages of the wedding planning. 22. I am planning to reserve rooms for my family, bridal party and guests; what special offer will I receive?

For a minimum of 10 rooms reserved, you will be entitled to a special group rate. Please contact our wedding specialists for details.

23. We are not Indonesian citizens, how will this affect the legalisation of our marriage?

Foreign citizens are required to obtain a Certificate of No Impediment (CNI) from their respective Embassies or Consulates. In addition, there will also be a number of documents which needs to be submitted. Please contact our wedding specialists for further details.

24. I am interested in having a pre wedding photo shoot in Conrad Bali. Who do I need to contact?

When you have confirmed your wedding at Conrad Bali, you are welcome to have a pre wedding photo shoot at our resort. Please contact your wedding coordinator to schedule your session.
